


CHILD-FRIENDLY CODE OF CONDUCT

Be ready to try, stretch your wings and let them fly.

Be fair, be true, share the space with someone new.

Be brave inside, let your heart be your guide.

Be honest and say if something feels wrong today.

Be soft, be light, treat your friends with care and might.

Be joyful too, dance your dance — the world needs YOU.

How to Use This Guide With Your Child

- Read one rhyme at a time and talk about what it means.
- Show the images and ask your child how they feel about them.
- Encourage your child to share examples from class or daily life.
- Revisit the guide regularly to reinforce safe, kind, and respectful habits.
- Celebrate when your child practices one of the values (kindness, honesty, bravery, gentleness, etc.).
